# **About Controller of Examinations Office**

We have incorporated all requisite provisions for the Planning, Conduct, Evaluation and Result declaration of Internal and External Evaluation of under graduate and post graduate programmes under the purview of Autonomous stream with effect from the Academic Year 2011-2012, Research programs M.Phil and Ph.D. programs will remain under the direct control of Bharathiar University. The basic orders/ rules regarding examination fees, attendance and ratio of internal and external examination components will be followed as per parent university rules and regulations. Thus, our aim is to streamline and optimize the examination system and bring out results at the earliest with a view to help the student community pursue higher studies or seek employment fast.

In accordance with the guidelines of the UGC to Autonomous Colleges, VLB Janakiammal College of Arts and Science (Autonomous) shall constitute an Examination Cell headed by COE on the basis of potential of the person nominated by the Principal. One Deputy Controller of Examinations and One Assistant Controller of Examinations will be appointed by the Principal.

The COE will create his/her own team with the approval of the Principal of the College. The team shall consist of deputy controller nominated depending on the quantum of work in the Examination Cell. Teachers working in the college shall be nominated in the Examination Cell for tenure of three years. They will continue performing their regular teaching work as scheduled by the college. There shall be a team of office assistants, computer programmers, data entry operators and other helpers in the Examination Cell. The Cell will have an appropriate printing

unit to prepare question papers and other confidential material. There shall be continuous and comprehensive evaluation of students through internal and external examinations

#### **Examinations System**

Examinations shall be conducted on Semester Pattern under Outcome Based Education. There will be one Premodel Examinations and one Model Examinations before the student appears for the Comprehensive Examination. The Premodel Examinations and Model Examination shall be conducted by the Internal Examination Committee under the Supervision of COE.

The Comprehensive Examinations shall be conducted by the Controller of the Examinations, twice in an Academic Year, in November/ December and in April/ May.

#### **Odd Semester**

The syllabus for the first, third and fifth semesters are taken printout on 04.07.2020. The College reopened (Online class) on 22.07.2020, after the summer vacation (lockdown due to pandemic COVID 19 situation). Head of the Departments are instructed to collect the first year Bio Data forms from the COE Office on or before 16.09.2020. On 22.07.2020 the departments were asked to submit the name list of the Elective and Allied students in the COE Section. The Practical exam notification for third and fifth semesters was sent to the departments on 04.12.2020 and for first years 06.02.2021. Last date for the Receipt of Pre-Model Question Paper was scheduled on 09.09.2020 for II and III year students. Pre Model Examinations timetable for II and III year students were commenced on 14.09.2020 as per the schedule and goes up to 19.09.2020 and for first year students from 07.12.2020 to 12.12.2020 (Online mode). The Controller of Examinations issued the Odd semester examinations application forms on 12.11.2020. The tentative timetable for the Comprehensive Examinations was prepared on 04.11.2020. The students were asked to pay their Odd Semester Examination Fees without fine from 18.11.2020 to 23.11.2020. The students those who had not paid their Examination fees were given grace days to pay their Fees with the fine amount of Rs.300 from 24.11.2020 to 26.11.2020. The Hall Tickets and Nominal Roll were prepared on 26.11.2020. The Odd semester

comprehensive exam time tables were finalized on 02.12.2020. The last date of the receipt of Model Examinations Question Paper was 02.12.2020 (II and III year Programme) and 21.01.2021 (for I year UG and PG programme). Model Examinations for II and III year Undergraduate and II year Postgraduate students were commenced from 07.12.2020 to 14.12.2020 for I year UG and PG students from 25.01.2021 to 03.02.2021 (through online mode). Hall Tickets were issued on.11.12.2020. The Practical Examinations commenced from 14.12.2020 to 16.12.2020 for II and III year UG and II year PG students, for I year UG and PG students from 11.02.2021 to 13.02.2021 (Online). Theory Examinations commenced from 17.12.2020 to 11.01.2021 for II and III year Undergraduate and II year Postgraduate students and for I year UG and PG students from 15.02.2021 to 27.02.2021 (Online). The Central Valuation (Online) for the odd semester was conducted from 11.01.2021 to 15.01.2020 for II and III years, for First year from 23.02.2021 to 01.03.2021. The examiners from various colleges were invited for the valuation. Passing Board meeting was held on 20.01.2021 for II and III years, on 08.03.2021 for First years. The results were published by the Controller of Examinations on 20.01.2021 for II and III years, on 08.03.2021 for First years. The Mark sheet was distributed to the students within 21 days of the publication of results.

The students were asked to pay their Even Semester Examination Fees without fine from 01.04.2021 to 08.04.2021. Pre-Model Examinations Commenced from 11.03.2021 to 17.03.2021 for II and III year students and from 07.04.2021 to 09.04.2021 for I year UG and PG students. The Hall Tickets and Nominal Roll were prepared on 08.04.2021. Semester Practical Schedule notification for Second, fourth and Sixth semester was sent on 24.03.2021. Last date for the Receipt of Model Question Paper was scheduled on 03.04.2021. Model Examinations both for II and III year Undergraduate and Postgraduate commenced from 15.04.2021 to 19.04.2021 (through online mode) and for I year UG and PG students from 12.05.2021 to 15.05.2021.
